

The Green Jobs Program offered through DC 37's **Education Fund encourages** members to take FREE training classes to prepare for green-collar jobs that support clean energy. Students are eligible to take introductory courses in Building Science Fundamentals, which then qualify them to move on to advanced courses in Building Auditing and Inspection, LEED Certification, Carbon Accounting, and more. Classes begin the first week of April.

Building Science Principles

This training provides participants with a foundation in the approaches and techniques of the residential energy efficiency upgrade process, by exposing students to the broad range of green job positions in the energy efficiency industry. Attendees will learn how typical buildings use energy, common areas of energy inefficiency, typical retrofit measures, and diagnostic testing procedures used to evaluate performance metrics.

Green Economy Overview

This three-hour course introduces participants to the 'Green Economy' and discusses sustainability development as it relates to renewable energy, being resource and carbon efficient and eliminating waste. Additionally, it discusses the green building sector and ways to increase the efficiency of resource use while reducing building impacts on human health and the environment.

GPRO Fundamentals

In this six-hour certificate course, students learn to see buildings differently and understand the strategies to make them efficient, healthy and resilient. It covers basic elements of green, high-performance construction and building operations as well as energy-consuming building systems and how to reduce building energy use.
